

Student Attendance Policy

- 1. The minimum attendance requirements for students are as follows:
 - Attendance for all students is compulsory.
- 2. The consequences for students who do not meet the minimum attendance requirements listed above are as follows:
 - Students are required to have a minimum in-class attendance of 80%. Attendance and lateness
 will be recorded on the attendance sheet by the Academic Department. Failure to adhere to the
 attendance requirements will lead to failure of the course.
 - We are required to inform IRCC if you are frequently absent and do not provide a doctor's note or other good reason. This may affect your temporary resident status.
- 3. The process by which students must report an absence is as follows:
 - All students must notify their teacher if they are unable to attend prior to class. In case of absence
 without notice, the teacher will contact the student to discuss the absence. In case of an
 emergency, students are required to reach out to their teacher or Academic Department to inform
 them of the absence. The Academic Team will discuss strategies with the students to improve
 their attendance.
 - If a student doesn't attend classes for three days or longer, the student must provide a doctor's note. We can only authorize absence from classes with a signed medical note or valid dated letters, and/or appointment details.
