

Submission of Fraudulent Documents Policy

Scope

This policy is applicable to all current students and/or prospective students of the The Language Gallery Canada ("TLGC").

Policy

The submission of documents such as transcripts, diplomas, test scores, references, payment confirmations, identification documents or applications, that are forged, fraudulent, altered from the original, materially incomplete, obtained under false pretenses or otherwise deceptive (collectively referred to as fraudulent documents) is prohibited by The Language Gallery Canada.

All documents submitted to TLGC, in support of applications for admission, academic evaluations or required administrative processing must be true, accurate and complete.

Supporting documents must not make misrepresentations, omit relevant information, or be altered from the original.

Any documents submitted under false pretenses, forged or misrepresented (in whole or part) shall subject the individuals involved to sanctions by TLGC. Specifically, TLGC reserves the right to withdraw offers of admission, place a temporary or permanent ban on applying for future admission, prohibit registration, rescind credentials, and suspend or expel students who present fraudulent documents. Such actions may also result in a forfeiture of academic credit earned while enrolled under false pretenses. Dismissal for misconduct does not abrogate a student's financial responsibility to TLGC. Students remain liable for all relevant tuition and fees and the payment of their debts according to the terms agreed upon their enrolment contract.
